
## **Coach's Corner**

## 40 Bowl Draw Drill

The test involves playing 40 draw shots:

- 20 forehands and 20 backhands in 10 ends
- For each end the mat is placed on the 2-metre mark
- One jack placed 23 metres from the mat and the other jack at the opposite 2-metre mark
- Play 4 bowls per end
- The hand to be played and jack position to draw to is specified for bowls
  1 & 2 and 3 & 4 for each end (refer card below)
- 1 point for each bowl within a MAT Length of the Jack
- 4 points in total can be scored each end
- If No score, mark bowls as N=Narrow, W=Wide, S=Short, L=Long
- Do the test with another bowler one plays one marks then swap over
